No re-buys or add-ons will be permitted during the Tournaments

Tournament Information:

- ❖ Each Tournament will comprise of a maximum of one hundred and thirty two (132) players
- ❖ Each session entrant will complete an Entry Form and pay all Fees at the Casino Cage at least 30 minutes prior to the commencement of the Tournament session.
- ❖ Only Total Star Rewards cardholders or Endeavour Room members may enter the tournament.
- ❖ Seats will be allocated by a manual or electronic system prior to the commencement of each Tournament.
- ❖ The order of wagering will be in accordance with the Star City Poker rules.
- ❖ Compulsory blinds will be placed whether a player(s) is present or not and cards will be folded at the completion of the initial deal if player(s) is not seated at the table. (As per Poker Rule 26.5.9.1)
- ❖ All players will be dealt cards regardless of whether they are present or not. (As per Poker Rule 26.5.9.2)
- ❖ Each entrant in a Tournament will be supplied with \$1,500 of non-value tournament chips at the table prior to the start of the tournament.
- ❖ The tournament will be conducted by the Tournament Supervisor in accordance with the tournament conditions and the applicable rules of the game. In the event of any inconsistency, the rules of the game prevail.
- ❖ The casino operator may refuse any application.

Tournament Schedule

- ❖ Tournaments will be held at the Main Gaming Floor Poker Pit, and commence at 12:15pm as per the listed dates.

Features

Star City Poker rules apply as varied by the Tournament Rules.

*Blinds will double in value until the conclusion of the Tournament.

The Final Nine (9) players at the conclusion of the Tournament, in order of elimination will be awarded the prize pool* as listed below.

All buy in's will be included in the prize pool; in addition to this a twenty-five dollar (\$25) administration fee will be charged.

Entry Fees and buy in's for all Tournament seats must be paid for at the Casino Cashier.

Tournament buy in's will only be refunded if notification is received at least five (5) days prior to the advertised date of the entered Tournament or at the discretion of the Tournament Supervisor. Entry fees are non-refundable.

*Should the number of entries be less than 132, the prize pool will be an amount equal to the buy in's paid by the players entered. In this case the prize pool will be broken down and paid in accordance with the Pay Out Breakdown below.

Should the entries for each tournament not total 88 or more, Star City reserves the right to cancel any of the scheduled Tournaments in accordance with Poker Rule 26.3.4. A maximum of \$30,000 is guaranteed for 132 entries. The prize pool will be made up of all buy in's collected and not refunded. The prize pool amounts may be rounded up at the discretion of the Tournament Supervisor.

(a) Tournament Structure

The tournament is limited to a maximum of 132 players.

The tournament shall consist of one event utilising up to twelve tables with a maximum of eleven players on each table.

The tournament supervisor will move players to facilitate the balancing and/or breaking of tables to ensure the efficient running of the tournament.

Tables will be balanced in order to maximize the number of players and to regulate approximate even numbers of players on each table as player and table numbers reduce.

The method of balancing tables will be: a player who is closest to the left of the big blind on a table with more players will fill the seat closest to the left of the big blind on a table with fewer players in order to even out player numbers.

As players are eliminated (lose all their chips) from the tournament, the Tournament supervisor will break tables from play in order to maximize the number of players at each table.

Tables will be broken in a pre -set order, with those players being assigned to empty seats at other tables as needed to ensure reasonable balancing.

Players seated on the new table assume all responsibilities of that position and shall be dealt in immediately. The only variation to this shall be if a new player to a table takes up a position between the small blind and the button, in this case they must wait until the button has passed.

The final table shall consist of up to 9 players and will be played until there is only one player remaining. That player shall be declared the overall tournament winner.

(b) Tournament Chips

Each player shall be issued with \$1,500 in non-value tournament chips prior to the start of the Tournament.

The order of wagering will be in accordance with the Star City Poker Rules.

(c) Allocation of wagering areas

Allocation of wagering/seat positions will be done by a manual or electronic system prior to the commencement of each tournament. In the case of a draw, numbered cards corresponding to the table seat positions will be drawn at the Buy In desk prior to the commencement of the tournament. The Tournament Supervisor will select a player and draw a numbered card. The selected player will be allocated the table seat position drawn.

(d) Wagers

The game shall commence as a \$25/\$25 blind.

There is no maximum limit to the size or number of raises permitted in each round of play. The minimum raise must not be lower than the table minimum and must not be less than any previous bet or raise in the betting round, except where a player goes all-in.

The Tournament Supervisor shall increase the blinds at his/her discretion, providing all players are advised prior to the round of play in which the blinds are to be increased and no wagers have been placed or cards dealt prior to the announcement. Any increase to the blinds will follow the order, as set out below, though may not necessarily progress to the maximum:

\$50/\$100
\$100/\$200
\$200/\$400
\$300/\$600
\$400/\$800
\$500/\$1000
\$700/\$1400
\$1000/\$2000
\$1500/\$3000
\$2000/\$4000 *

*Blinds will double in value until the conclusion of the Tournament.

(e) Time restriction

The Tournament Supervisor may impose a time restriction on any player deemed to be taking too long to make a decision.

On being advised by the Tournament Supervisor that the time limit is being imposed the player shall then be given 40 seconds to make and act on their decision. A player who fails to make a decision within the 40-second time limit will be required to fold their hand.

(f) Entry:

Buy in of two hundred and twenty five dollars will be included in the prize pool, an additional twenty five dollar entry fee will be payable in advance to the Casino operator. Entry totals \$250 per player.

There will be no re-buys or add-ons permitted.

All Fees for Tournament seats must be paid for at the Casino Cashier at least 30 minutes prior to the scheduled start of the tournament.

Entries are not transferable.

(g) Eligibility for entry:

Only persons entitled to enter the casino and gamble that are Total Star Rewards cardholders or Endeavour Room members are eligible to enter the tournament.

Entry into the tournament is by application only and at the discretion of the Tournament supervisor. Entries are non transferable.

A Poker Tournament entry form is to be completed and submitted with all fees payable to the Casino Cashier at least 30 minutes prior to the scheduled start of the tournament.

(h) Prizes

Prizes will be paid in full by cheque by the casino operator at the cage following the conclusion of the tournament.

The prize pool for 132 entries will be guaranteed as per the following table. *

Should the entries for each tournament not total 88 or more, Star City reserves the right to cancel any of the scheduled Tournaments in accordance with Poker Rule 26.3.4. A maximum of \$30,000 is guaranteed for 132 entries. The prize pool will be made up of all buy in's collected and not refunded. The prize pool amounts may be rounded up at the discretion of the Tournament Supervisor.

The tournament is conducted by the Tournament Supervisor, in accordance with the applicable rules of the game and the Tournament Conditions. In the event of any inconsistency, the rules will prevail.

Tournament buy in's will only be refunded if notification is received at least five (5) days prior to the advertised date of the entered Tournament or at the discretion of the Tournament Supervisor. Entry Fees are non-refundable.

A disqualified player will not be entitled to any refund of any buy in or fees paid (As per Poker Rule 26.8.4), and will not be eligible for any part of the prize pool.

The casino operator may refuse any application.
